Ticket subsidy for ACT artists

With the support of Arts ACT, NAVA welcomes artists to apply for a bursary of the ticket price to attend Future/Forward 2018.

We are looking for artists who will directly benefit from attending Future/Forward and who demonstrate an active engagement in the arts sector.

We prioritise a strong diversity of artists attending and so we strongly encourage applications from Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists; regional artists; artists of Culturally and Linguistically Diverse backgrounds; people with disability.

Dates

Applications close at 23:59 AEST, **Saturday 21 July**, 2018 and successful recipients will be notified by **28 July**.

Future/Forward will take place on 14-15 August in Canberra, and successful recipients are required to book their tickets by 1 August.

Successful recipients will receive their ticket via email by 25 July.

Terms & Conditions

- Bursaries are open to individual artists in the Australian Capital Territory only.
- The bursary is for professional artists. We define professional artists as those who have had exhibitions, sale of work, grants, prizes and/or awards.
- The bursary is to cover the ticket to Future/Forward 2018 only.
- Please complete the application form on the NAVA website by the deadline, late applications will not be assessed.

Payment

No payment details are required. The successful recipient will receive the ticket via email.

Acquittal

If you are successful, we ask that you complete an acquittal of the bursary within four weeks of the event.
