

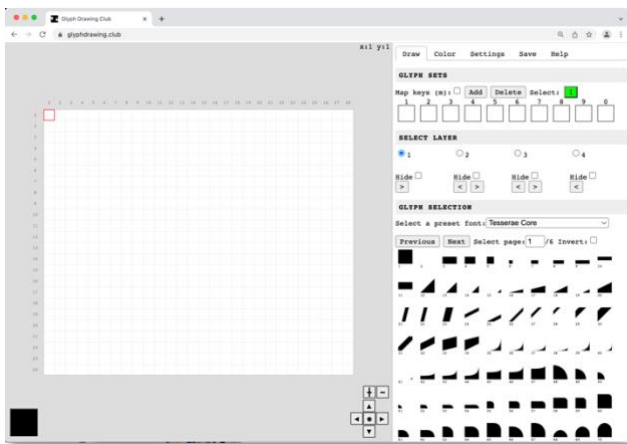
## Glyph Drawing with April Phillips

### Mission:

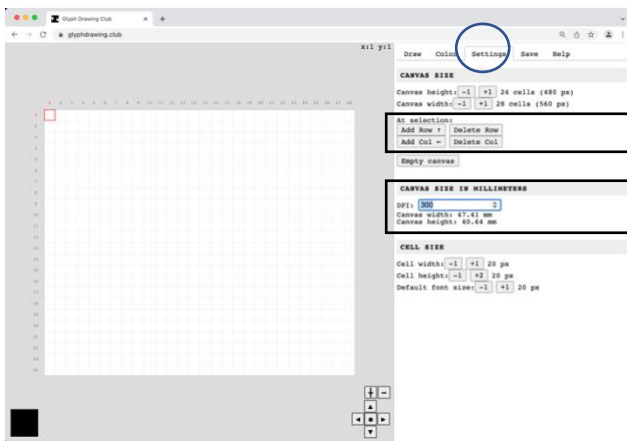
- Complete a black and white glyph drawing
- Include 3 elements:
  - A defined space, area or shape: 'the gallery'
  - Visual things that you are exploring in your visual arts practice
  - Title for a solo exhibition of your visual art works

### Steps:

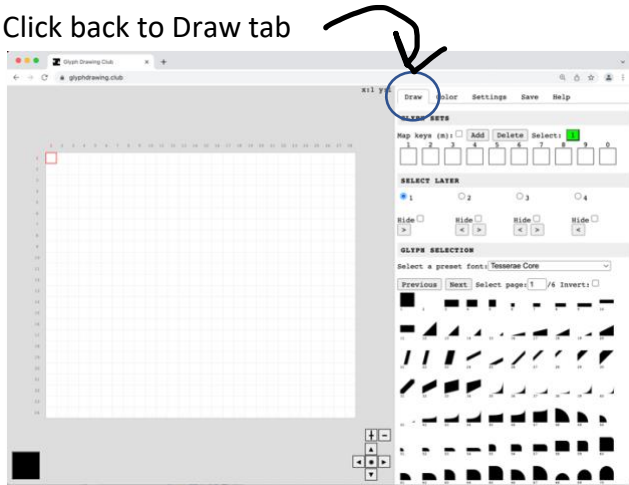
1. Go to: [glyphdrawing.club](http://glyphdrawing.club)  
You are here!



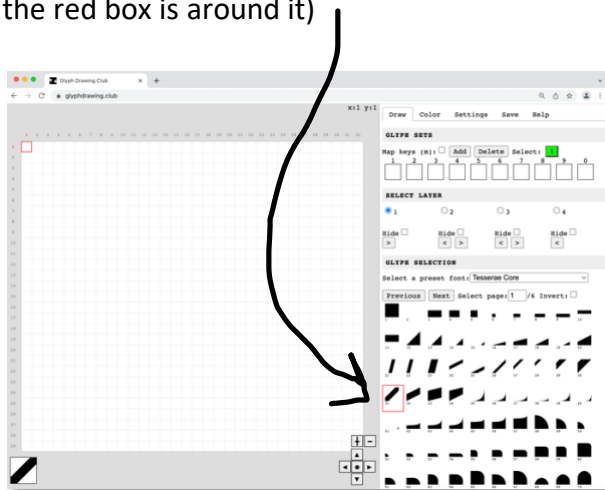
2. Click on the 'settings' tab  
At selection: Add row ↑ x 5 and Add col ↓ x 5  
Canvas size: increase to 300 DPI (a good resolution for printing)



3. Click back to Draw tab



4. Select a glyph from the current group 'tesserae core' (you will know its selected when the red box is around it)



5. Click onto the canvas where you would like to place the glyph.

Try out these actions:

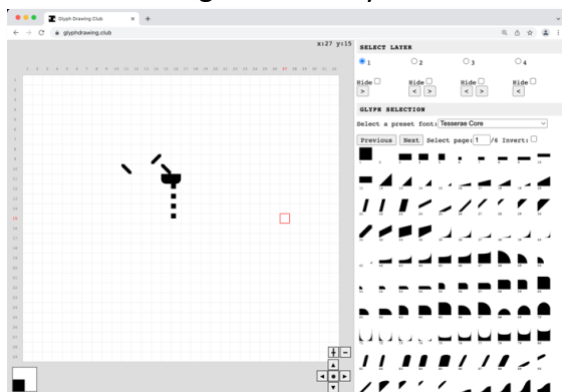
Q or Return / Enter = draw

F = flip

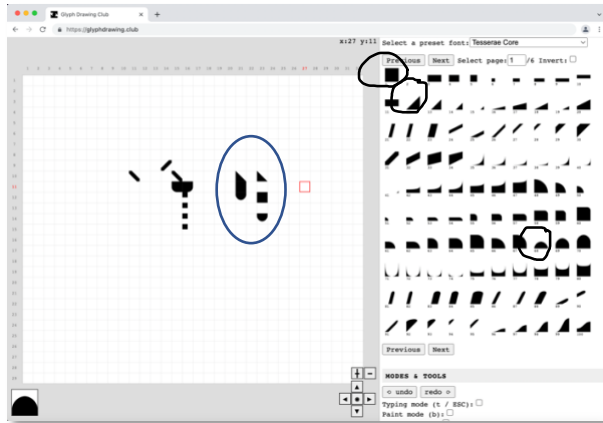
R = rotate

space bar = delete

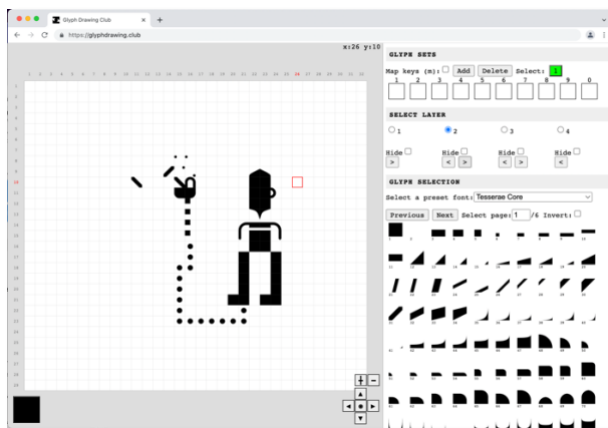
arrows or click = navigate around your canvas



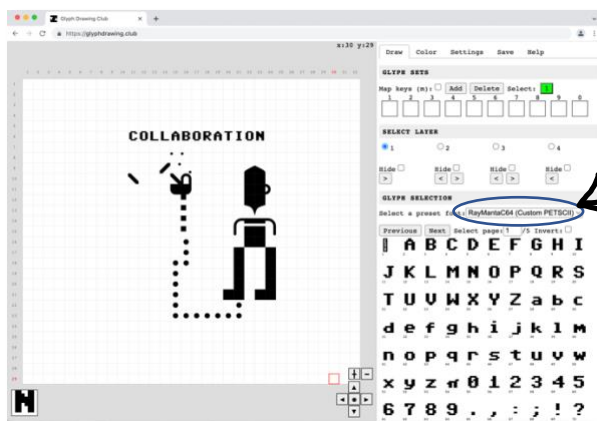
- Tip: Glyphs connect to make new shapes.  
Square 1 | Triangle 12 | Semi circle 68

  - Something from your visual arts practice

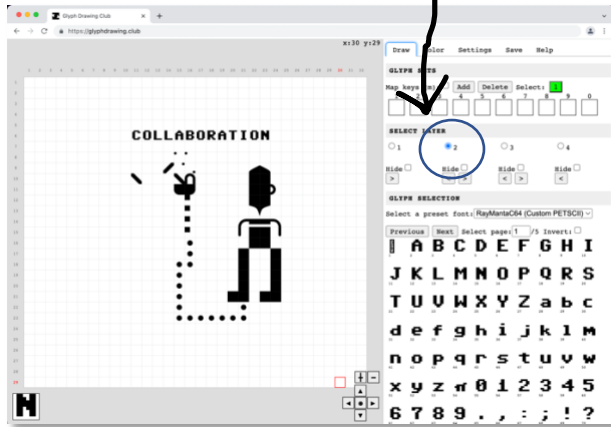


- Time to place your Exhibition title!  
Select a new set of glyphs: Raymanta

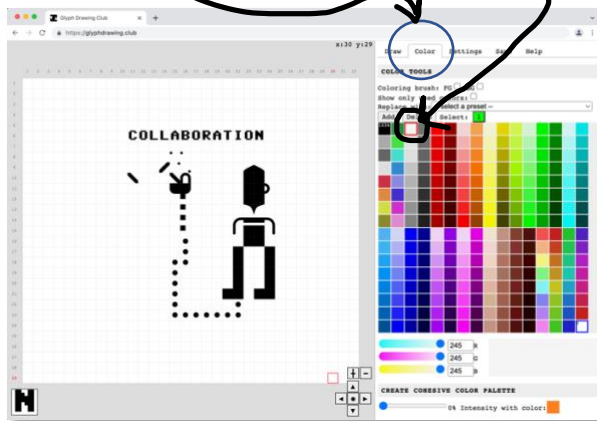


- Have extra time?

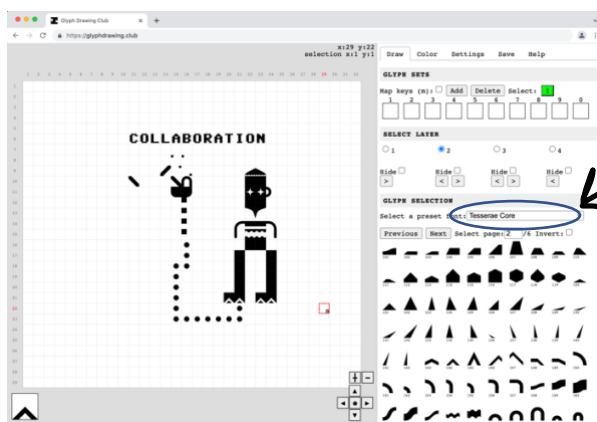
Add some white details in a new layer.  
Click on layer 2. Button



10. Click on colour tab and select white

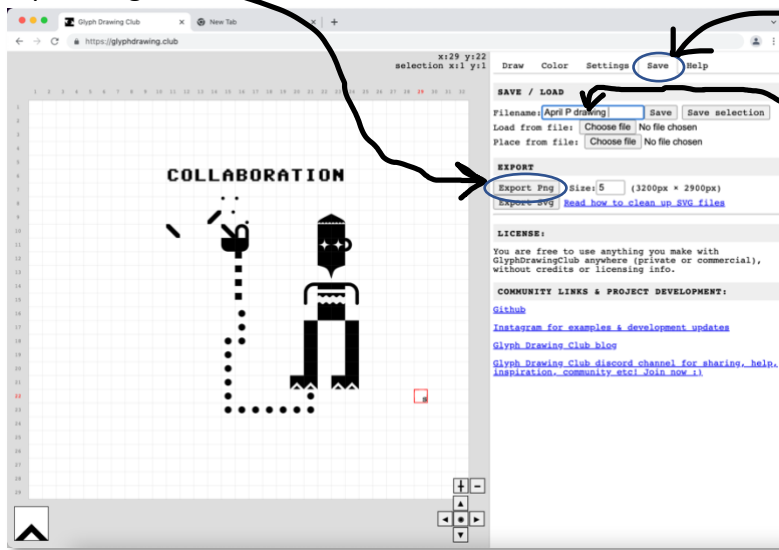


11. Select 'tesserae core'  
add some white glyphs over the top of your drawing



12. Ready to save!

Click on 'save' tab  
Rename your file: First name, initial and drawing e.g April P Drawing  
Export Png



13. Look out for the pop up!

A pop up should appear in the bottom right hand corner of the screen that says "Copy to Clipboard" - Click on this.
